God perfectly equipped the bee for gathering pollen. It sticks its "tongue" like a straw into the flower to suck the nectar out.

Tiny hairs on its body collect the sticky pollen as it moves within the flower.

"Combs" and "brushes" on the hind legs clean the middle legs to remove it. The middle legs clean the forelegs. The forelegs clean the eyes and front of the bee. The pollen is then carried in baskets on the outer part of the hind legs. All these tools, and more, equip the bee for its work.

We would look at the carpenter's tools and say that he intelligently picked all those tools to equip him for the jobs of the day. In the same way, we know that God picked the tools of the bee for its work among the flowers in the meadows.
